Greetings Hamburg,

Hope everyone is doing well. Mother Nature teased us with the warmer weather and now brings us back to reality. We can handle it.

City Council met this past Tuesday. We heard updates from Chief Siewert that included the addition of a new firefighter, the future purchase of a grass rig, the new Christmas Lights have arrived, and the replacing of air packs. Council, Staff, and Chief discussed the possibility of moving the ice rink to the vacant lot on Brad Street.

The Park Bathroom remodeling is a step closer to reality as the Council approved bids for electrical, plumbing, and concrete work. In addition to funding the Park remodel, the City Council awarded bids to do electrical work at the grinder station as well as concrete work at the grinder station and Community Hall. Soon bids will be taken for work on Brad Street.

Staff provided an update on resolution of the Trebesch Litigation. We are waiting on Trebesch to provide the City with updated Deeds and to file the Deeds with the County. With money from the cable fund, the Council approved to upgrade the projector and sound system at City Hall.
