

# A Message from Mayor Lund

## Greetings Hamburg

Hope all are doing well and enjoying the start of summer. Mother Nature is doing her best to keep our lawns green. While it can be a challenge to keep pace with cutting the lawn, please try your best as we have activities in town that bring people in.

Hamburg's City-Wide Garage Sales is right around the corner. June 19<sup>TH</sup> to the 22<sup>ND</sup>. We will see a lot of traffic over those days. Keep an eye out for those darting from garage sale to garage sale. Also, try to remind anyone that parks near or in front of a mailbox to move their vehicle.

Unfortunately, I was not able to attend the City Council meeting Tuesday as I was in Florida for NASAA training. While you may think I am enjoying sunny weather, it rained over 12 inches on Wednesday and another 12 inches from noon on Thursday into the late afternoon Friday. Thanks to Councilman Polzin for running the show.

The City Council heard from the public and had a discussion on flying the new Minnesota State flag and a final decision will come at our next meeting. Due to logistics, the next City Council meeting will be July 16<sup>TH</sup>. The Council approved liquor licenses for Know It All's Bar & Grill as well for the Hamburg Baseball Club. City Staff reported that to repair the city electronic sign at Bi-Centennial Park is estimated to cost \$4,500.

If you have not seen it or heard, the City of Hamburg does have its own Facebook page. The purpose of the Facebook page is to provide timely updates and on goings in the city. The City Staff nor Council will monitor the responses to posts. We do ask that everyone be adults when posting on Hamburg's Facebook page.

Other items the City Council addressed during the meeting included the increase of our maintenance workers wage by \$1 due to passing the Class D Sewer test; approved Jaguar Communications Settlement agreement that states they will no longer provide TV service after June 30<sup>TH</sup>; public nuisances were sent out with a due date of compliance of July 16<sup>TH</sup>; and City Staff is working on an ordinance to change out old water meters and require home sellers to repair water shutoff valves prior to selling.

Please note that City Offices will be closed June 19<sup>th</sup> in observance of Juneteenth holiday. Juneteenth is the oldest-known celebration marking the end of slavery in the United States. The end of June will be busy at Hawks Field. The Hamburg Hawks will take on Plato June 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 pm; Green Isle June 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:30 pm; and Winsted June 25<sup>TH</sup> at 7:30 pm. Come on out to the park and cheer on the Hawks!

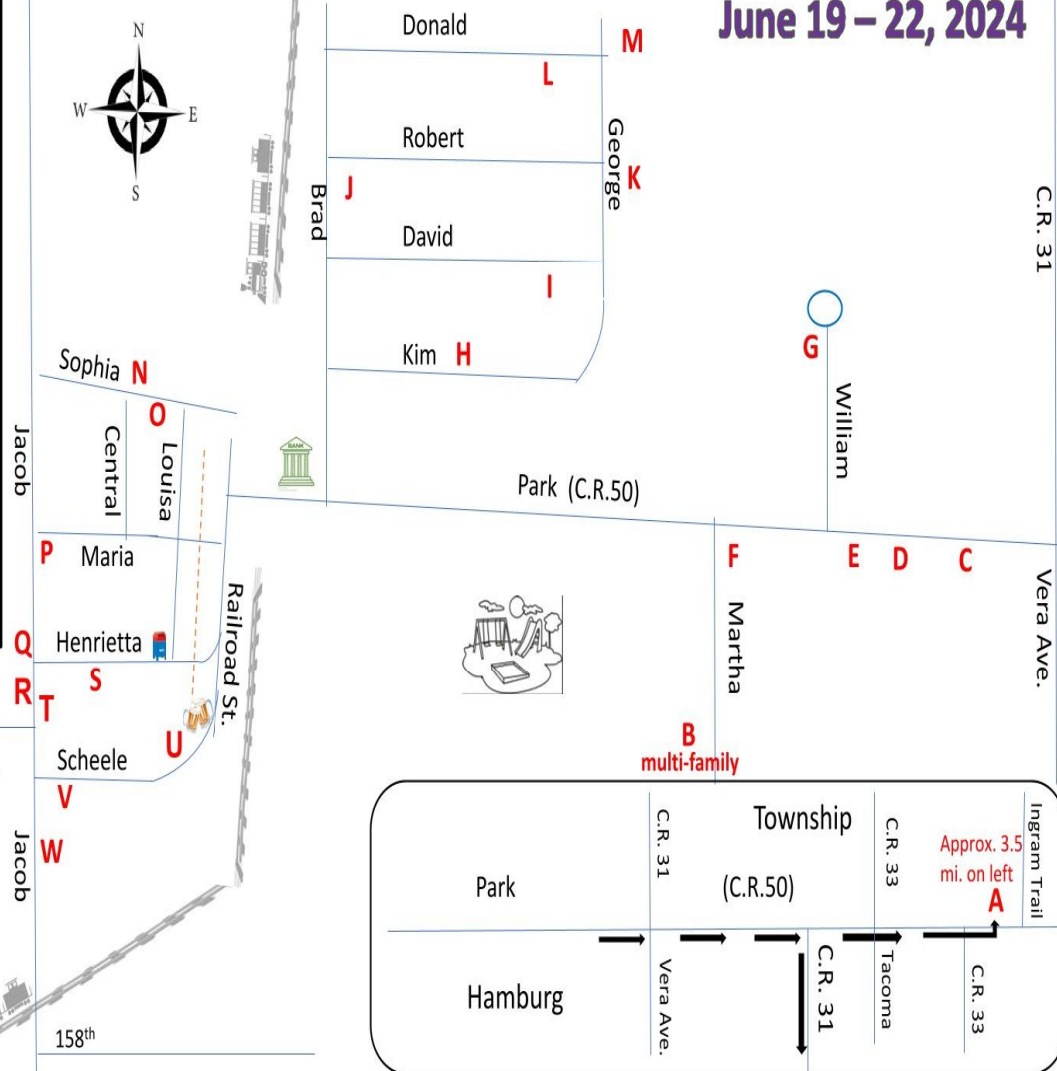
