

A message from Mayor Lund



Greetings Hamburg Residents,

I hope you are doing well and staying warm since Mother Nature turned on the cold, snow, and wind this past week. Thank you to everyone that removed their vehicles from the streets for snow removal. I would hate to see anyone get a ticket or towed for not moving their vehicle after/during snowfall. If you have not already done so, please follow me on Facebook, as I try to set up a post prior to the plows going out as a warning.

Next weekend is already Halloween! We are suggesting that everyone follow MDH guidelines when out Trick-or-Treating. Please do not participate in Halloween if you are feeling ill. Otherwise, if you see a group at a door, please social distance before approaching. The HFD will also be out with the rigs and handing out candy.

As of October 19th, Carver County has confirmed 1,696 COVID Cases. Next week, Tuesday-Thursday, free community COVID testing will be done at Lake Waconia Event Center from noon to 6 pm. Elections are just a few weeks away. There is still a chance to vote by mail if you like or you can wait until Election Day to vote in person.
