

A Message from Mayor Lund



Greetings Hamburg Residents,

Hope you are doing well and being safe. This past Wednesday, Governor Walz dialed things back. Per Minnesota Executive Order 20-99:

- *All bars and restaurants will no longer be allowed to have guest indoors and dine-in. Takeout orders only. Fitness centers are closed.
- *Adult and youth sports are paused – although collegiate and professional sports can continue.
- *Weddings, funerals and similar planned ceremonies can be held but all receptions and gatherings around the ceremonies are to be canceled or postponed.
- *Minnesotans should not gather with anyone outside of their immediate household – outdoors or indoors.

The Executive Order is effective from Friday the 20th of November at 11:59 pm to December 18th at 11:59 pm. The good news is that barbershops, salons and other personal care services business can remain open while adhering to MDH guidelines. With that said, the Hamburg Fire Department Meat Raffles have been suspended for the immediate future.

The Hamburg Lions continue to supply the Little Library with various items. The Little Library is in the Security Bank drive thru. Remember to “Light up Hamburg in 2020” for a chance to win money. If you live in rural Hamburg please contact Diana (467-2211) or Diane (467-3534) to get on the list to be judged. Residents in town will not need to call. Judging will take place the week of December 14th. Top prize \$300.

During the White House COVID update call this past week, we learned that two possible vaccines are nearly set for approval. The FDA still needs to give approval. While we wait for approval, Operation Warp Speed will be testing the distribution chain to ensure the vaccine can get out as quickly as possible. The first batches of the vaccine will be distributed to those with immediate need.

City Hall will remain closed to in person traffic until after Thanksgiving. If you need something or have a question, call city hall or email. City Council meetings for the rest of 2020 will be done via Zoom. The Budget workshop on December 1st will also be done via Zoom.
