**Greetings Hamburg** 

Hope the start of 2022 has treated everyone well. The Personnel Committee met last week to discuss the applications received for the General Maintenance position. The list was pared down to 5 candidates which the Personnel Committee will be interviewing in the coming week. The goal is to have a candidate recommendation set for the March City Council meeting.

On the 16<sup>th</sup> of February, the City was to have had a pre-trial hearing on the property in dispute at the heart of Hamburg. The pre-trial meeting was postponed until March 23<sup>rd</sup>. We are still awaiting the Judge's ruling from the court appearance in January.

The redistricting maps are out, and Hamburg is now in Senate District 17 and House District 17B. Rep. Glenn Gruenhagen and Sen. Scott Newman are now representing the interests of Hamburg. Sen.
