City Council had a busy month as we convened twice for the good of the city. The hope is our new maintenance worker will be on the job and learning the ropes by the first week of April. The process has been started to secure bids on the mill and overlay projects for Louisa Street and Maria Avenue. That leaves just Brad Street left for major overhaul. With the assistance of SEH and City Staff, the Council has been able to keep our streets in great condition with minimal impact on resident's pocketbooks.
