Hope everyone is doing well and staying healthy. Mother Nature has given some nice weather as of late and it appears to be mild until Thanksgiving too. On Tuesday the City Council met and awarded the sealed bid for 2011 Ford Ranger. The winning bid was \$7,501.50.

The City Council next meeting will be on Tuesday November 21<sup>st</sup> at 7 pm. A Public Hearing will start the night and then a Special Meeting will commence to address the Minor Subdivision. The City Council will hold a second meeting of month on the 28<sup>th</sup> to finalize the 2024 Budget and to perform employee reviews. A Public Hearing is set prior to the December 12<sup>th</sup> meeting to receive input on the 2024 City Fee Schedule. The 2024 City Fee Schedule will be finalized later that evening.

The Hamburg Fire Department will hold their annual Toy Drive Breakfast at Know It All's Bar & Grill on Sunday the 10<sup>th</sup> from 8 to 11 am.

Mayor's In Time will be held on Monday December 4<sup>th</sup> from 5 to 7 pm at City Hall. It has been a fun year as many residents have stopped in to express their thoughts. I encourage anyone wanting to know about things happening with the city to come up and ask your questions or offer up suggestions.
