Hope everyone is doing well and being safe. Mother Nature started our week out with summer and ended it with fall. Thanks to everyone that gave feedback on the City-Wide Garage Sales. Based on the feedback, the plan will be to keep it in June.

At our last City Council meeting, we approved a liquor license for Know It All's Bar & Grill LLC. We will be closing applications for the seasonal help position at the end of April with the goal of getting some hired in the first part of May. At next meeting, in May, we will have a public hearing for a variance request for 480 Henrietta Avenue. The public hearing will take place at 7 pm with the City Council meeting to follow. Other items approved at our last Council meeting was a 3-year contract with Clark Environmental Mosquito Management Program and a Joint Powers Agreement with the State of Minnesota.

Sunday, April 16th, the Hamburg Fire Relief Association will be hosting their Annual Windsor Pork Chop Dinner at the fire hall. Starts at 10 am. For \$15 you get a pork chop, scalloped potatoes, corn, dinner roll, desert, and a beverage. For an additional \$8 you can score another pork chop.

As the weather improves and becomes more summer like, please be mindful of people being out and about. Kids do not always look both ways before bolting across the street or while riding their bicycles.


We still have a large snow pile across from the Community Hall. When do you think it will be completely melted away?
